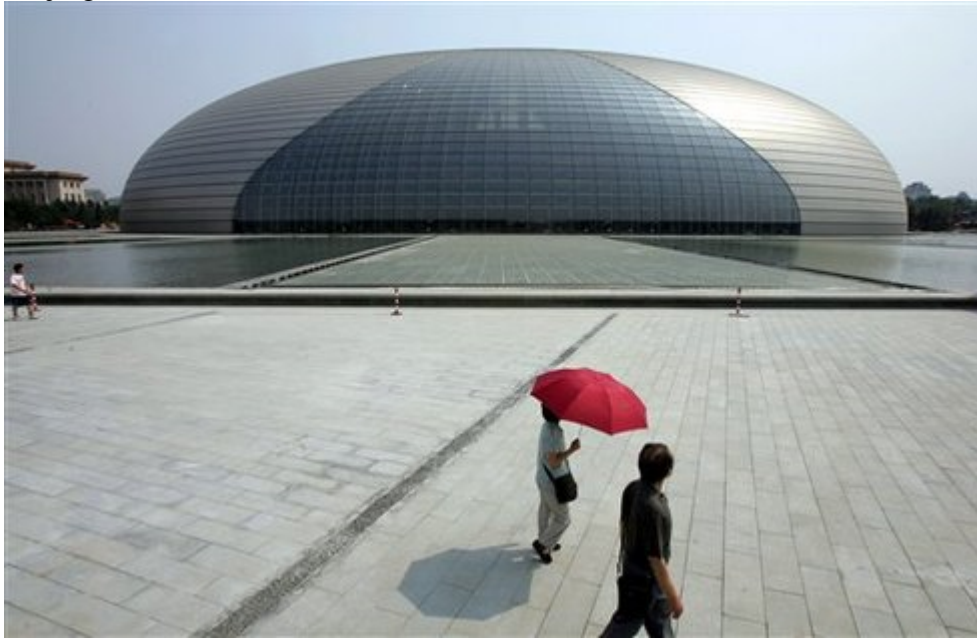

Xing Hai Theatre 1,500 seats

Also located on Er Sha Island, Xing Hai Theatre has a 1,500-seat grand theatre and 460-seat concert hall. The theater was named to commemorate Xi Xing Hai, the famous musician who was the son of a fisherman. East of the main building is the Cultural Square with a bronze statue of Xi Xing Hai as well as the musical fountain and the “stage-on-water”. The North Square is decorated by stone carving of ‘green dragon’ and ‘white tiger.’ The South Square has large patterns of sails which symbolizes the fisherman culture which dominated the southern coast in the past.

Shenzhen Music Hall – 1500 seats

Shenzhen Music Hall is located in the Center of Futian District, Shenzhen City, covering a total area of 0.26345 million Square meters and the construction area of approximately 0.414233 million square meters, designed by the Japanese architect Master ISOZAKI

As an important component of the exhibition center, the theatre is situated in central Harbin. With a magnificent main building and green plants nearby, it is the largest theatre in Heilongjiang Province. The 7,585-square-meter theatre has over 2,000 soft seats. In the past years, the theatre has hosted many provincial conferences and cultural performances home and abroad. The Concert of Summer in Harbin, has been set here in recent years. This theatre has become an important place for the political, economic, cultural, scientific and technological exchanges in Harbin and Heilongjiang Province.
